## Job Responsibilities

This includes safely setting up and adjusting exercise equipment, instructing, and monitoring exercise performance, helping provide prescribed home exercise programs, and assisting with set up/delivery of therapeutic modalities (e.g., ESTIM, hot/cold packs, etc.) as prescribed and appropriate.
- Assist Personal Trainer, Group Fitness Instructor, and Massage Therapist as allowable by state statutes. This may include administrative or house keeping tasks.
- Perform orthotic screenings, Class IV Laser treatments, and additional services offered. Refer clients for wellness services.
- Implementing and complying with FYZICAL's PTRx model through all client communications and actions.
- Develop a professional and personal rapport with each patient that enhances their experience and builds connections.

- Receive and stores linen. Maintains an adequate supply of linen necessary for daily functioning of the clinic.
- Maintains adequate medical supplies. Performs weekly inventory of medical supplies and orders supplies as needed.
- Maintain proper chart documentation, schedule patient follow-up appointments, organize and print home exercise programs for patients.
- Following all CDC and Health Department Guidelines to maintain a safe and sanitary workspace. Assist with maintaining the clinic's equipment and facility standards.
